Exam Officer's Report

Module Exams

In 2024, six people took, and passed, module exams – two taking module 1, one taking module 2, three taking module 3 and one person taking module 6.

In-person exams remain popular, and I would like to thank Jan French of Braintree division for kindly organizing and invigilating the in-person exams in November 2024 and March 2025.

Eleven candidates are set to take Module exams on 22 March 2025:

Online: 3 (modules 1, 3 and 5)In person: 8 (modules 1, 2, 3 and 5)

Basic Assessments

In 2024, 27 beekeepers took their basic assessments and all of them passed. Six people passed with Distinction and were given a Miss Avey Award and £50. Sixteen people passed with credit and five people attained a pass.

Certificates were awarded at Conference in November. The majority of recipients did not attend so their certificates were sent on to them or passed to their local divisions for presentation.

Members gaining their Basic Assessment came from the following divisions: Braintree (2); Chelmsford (8); Epping Forest (10); Saffron Walden (7) and Southend (1).

Junior Certificate

One candidate, from Epping Forest Division, took and passed the Junior Assessment.

Honey Bee Health Certificate

There were six candidates for the Bee Health exam in 2024 from the following divisions: Braintree (4), Chelmsford (2), all of whom passed.

EBKA awards

This is a reminder that in the autumn of 2024 the CEC agreed that members who sign up from 2025 onwards will receive 50% of the entry cost.

Miss Avey and Ted Hooper Awards are presented to anyone who achieves a distinction in the Basic or module exams, both awards include a monetary award, currently £50.
